Pinewood Derby Rules

All cars must pass the following inspections to qualify for the race.

1. The car is to be built by the scout, with the help of an adult.
2. The car shall be constructed during the current year of scouts. You may not use a car from a previous year.
3. Width shall not exceed 2.75 inches.
4. Length shall not exceed 7 inches. (No extensions)
5. Weight shall not exceed 5 oz.
6. Axles, wheels and body shall be from the material provided in the Official Grand Prix Pinewood Derby Kit. (no solid axles, nails from kit only)
7. Wheel bearings, washers, bushings, and hubcaps are prohibited.
8. Axles may not be altered in any way except for polishing.
9. You must use the supplied slots for the axles.
10. Axles may only be lubricated with powdered graphite or powdered Teflon.
11. You may not use liquid lubricants. No Grease, oil or flubber
12. Wheels may be lightly sanded to smooth out molding imperfections in the tread area. Beveling, tapering, thin sanding, wafering, or lathe turning of the wheels are prohibited. All four wheels must contact the track.
13. The car shall not ride on any kind of spring.
14. No loose materials of any kind are allowed on, in or under the car.
15. The car must be freewheeling, with no starting devices.
16. There must be a minimum of 3/8" clearance under the car for track clearance.
17. If a car leaves the track during a race, the race will be run again. If the same car leaves the track a second time, the car will be placed last in that heat.
18. If a car receives any damage during a race, a maximum of 5 minutes will be allowed for repair time. The car has to be re-inspected before racing again. Once cars have been inspected and placed on the holding table behind the race flag line, owners may not touch or handle their cars until the conclusion of all races.
19. Should any dispute arise, final decision lies with the race committee made up of one representative from each unit and the race marshal.
